RATES INCLUDE:

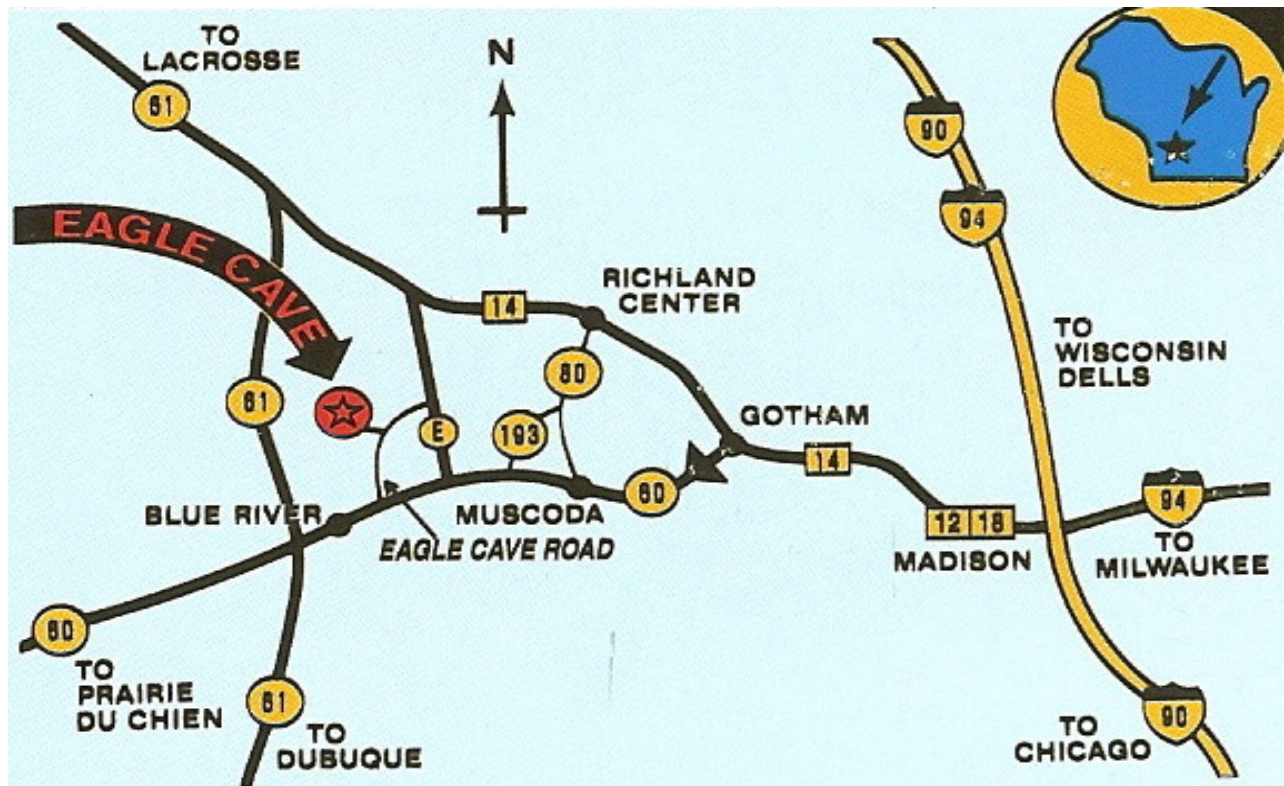
- Adventure guide "caveman challenge games" for coveted traveling trophy currently held by the Phoenix
- Snack on Friday Night, Breakfast Lunch and dinner on Saturday, Breakfast on Sunday
- All activities on Saturday
- In or out of cave sleeping on Friday and Saturday nights. If you camp inside EAGLE CAVE the average temperature is 52°
- General exploration of over 3000 feet of subterranean tunnels.
- Hike over 12 miles of trails ranging from 1 miles. to 5 miles.
- 16 compass courses (10 novice- 4 intermediate- 2 advanced)
- Compete in the gold nugget competitive trail
- Fishing on Little Blackhawk Lake (excellent bass and bluegill fishing)
- Night-mar-a-thon; Is a night hike led by the Eagle Cave staff. (last activity of Sat. evening)
- Use of all the facilities; Cafeteria, game room, bath house, and much, much more.

Directions and Map to Eagle Cave. It is approximately 200 miles away

- **I-90 to Madison, WI.**
- **Exit on hwy 12-18 west to Middleton**
- **Take hwy 14 west through Cross Plains, Black Earth, Arena, Spring Green, and Lone Rock to Gotham.**
- **Turn left in Gotham on hwy 60 west. (gas station sits on the corner of hwy 14 and 60)**
- **Follow hwy 60 alongside the Wisconsin River to the 4-way stop of hwy 60 and 80.**
- **Keep going straight through the intersection on hwy 60 for 6 mi.**
- **The EAGLE CAVE sign will be on the left side of the road, take a right at the sign and follow Eagle Cave Rd for about 2 mi.**
- **By lake turn left on Cavern Ln**
