



Winter Campout Night at the Museum Of Science and Industry



Date and time: Sat Feb 27, 5:30pm to Sun 8:30am Museum of Science and Industry

Cost: \$100 for dad and son. Each addl son is \$45.00. Payment is due by the Jan 9th Boat Regatta.

Parking: Museum's indoor garage on the west side of the Museum. Parking is not included in the price. The fee is \$16/vehicle so save some money by car pooling.

Check-in: Each person must have their ticket and release form. Late arrivals are no problem.

What to bring: Sleeping bag, pillow, air mattress and flashlight (electricity is avail). T-shirt and sweat pants should be worn, not PJs. If hygiene is a priority, a toothbrush, washcloth, small towels and other toiletries can be brought.

What not to bring: Tent, expensive electronics, slippers, food or drinks. Alcohol is strictly prohibited.

Food: A night time snack and continental breakfast is provided. There is also a food court that will be open at the early part of the evening.

Sleeping area: We will have an assigned a sleeping spot.

Activities: We will have a photo scavenger hunt, so bring a camera or camera phone. There are scheduled activities that you can attend or just wander the museum at your own pace until midnight. The Omnimax and temporary exhibits are avail for an addl fee of \$5.50/person. We will provide a program schedule as soon as the museum has the information.

Lights out: 12:00am. If you do stay up, you may be asked to move to a designated area.
