OFFICIAL RULES

Adventure Guides Mustang Expedition

2010 Pinewood Derby

presented by The Rough Riders Outfit

1. All cars must be presented for inspection;
2. The car weight must not exceed 5.0 ounces. The official race scale is considered final;
3. The overall car length may not exceed 7 inches;
4. The overall width of the car may not exceed 2 3/4 inches;
5. The car must have 1-3/4 inches of clearance between the wheels;
6. The car must have 3/8" clearance underneath the body;
7. The wood provided in the kit must be used. The block may be shaped in any way that is desired;
8. The wheels supplied with the kit must be used. The wheels may not be cut, drilled, beveled, or rounded. You may remove the seam from the wheels.
9. The axels OR nails provided with the kit must be used. They may be polished and/or lubricated.
10. Only dry lubricant may be used;
11. ALL LUBRICATION MUST BE DONE PRIOR TO INSPECTION; no lube allowed in the Y;
12. Wheel bearings, bushings, or washers are prohibited;
13. The car must not ride on any type of springs;
14. The car must be free-wheeling, with no starting devices;
15. No loose material may be present on the car; all weights must be fixed to the car.
16. Appearance details (paint, decals, figures, details, etc.) are permitted as long as they do not cause the car to exceed weight and size limits, and are firmly attached to the car.

Each car must pass inspection by the official inspection committee before it will be allowed to compete. A Help Shop will be available to assist in making qualifying corrections to cars that need it. The Inspection Committee has the responsibility to disqualify cars that cannot meet these specifications.

Race Rules:

1. Only one car allowed per registered entrant;
2. If a car leaves its lane, the track chairman will inspect the track and, if a track fault is found which probably caused the lane violation, the chairman may order the race re-run after repairs to the track are made.
3. If, during a race, a car leaves the track without interfering with an opponent and no track fault is found, it shall be considered to have ended its heat at that point.
4. If, during a race, a car leaves its lane and no track fault is found, and the car interferes with an opponent, the heat will be re-run without the offending car.
5. If, during a race, no car reaches the finish line, the car which went the farthest in its lane shall be considered the winner.
6. Handling of the cars after inspection (except by the Inspection Committee and Race Officials) is prohibited. An exception will be made for repairs.
7. Repair time between heats is limited to 2.5 minutes.

Dads Race Rules:

All above rules apply, EXCEPT:

1. Dads may utilize any pine car kit available, but must provide their own kits.
2. Any speed modifications are allowable (thin wheels, bushings, etc.), but must maintain standards for weight and car size.
